2014-2015 Achievements and Activities

As a direct result of your continued generous support, SPTS continues to advance our mission on both local and national levels. In the past 12 months we have been involved in numerous projects and activities, which we are proud to inform you about as follows:

Maureen continues to travel across the country to provide suicide prevention training and consultation to the numerous states that have contracted with us:

- The federal Garrett Lee Smith Memorial Act funding for New York State expired at the end of fiscal year 2014. Over the past three years Maureen was able to provide training across 26 counties within New York State and SPTS continues to build upon the valuable relationships that she initiated. Due to the sustainability of our programming, many areas continue successful implementation of Lifelines.

- Maureen continues her work with the state of Georgia to provide training to educators from Atlanta to Valdosta. She provided “Starfish” and GOALs training to leaders who will begin support groups for adolescent survivors of suicide. Maureen trained 500 school support staff in September 2014 in suicide intervention training, to ensure that the entire district is prepared to help students in need.

- Oklahoma is another state that Maureen frequently provides training and consultation to. The state has provided training for public school educators, tribal communities, members of the Catholic church and military personnel.

- SPTS maintains its relationship with the state of Delaware in providing continued support. At a national conference this past April, it was presented by state staff that there was a nearly 50% decrease in suicidal ideation and attempts by middle school students following the implementation of the Lifelines Prevention curriculum.

- Maureen provided a keynote presentation to hundreds of Missouri educators in December 2014.

- Maureen presented to key community stakeholders in Midland, Texas in January 2015 to address their concerns of teen suicide. She is scheduled to be a keynote speaker at a conference in 2015.

In the week following our 2014 Outing, Maureen and Scott responded to a request from the Harlem High School for Math, Science and Engineering following the death of one of their students. They presented to a group of concerned parents and provided the school with resources for its faculty, students and parents.

September is “Suicide Prevention Awareness Month”. September of 2014 was the first organized awareness campaign by SPTS and is estimated to have provided information to over 100,000 local residents. NJ Transit distributed information flyers to 10,000 customers; Scott Fritz was interviewed for NJ TV; Dawn Doherty was interviewed for NJ 12; Denise Wegeman and Dawn Doherty discussed the issue of teen suicide on the Lou and Liz Morning Show on 94.3.

2014-2015 Achievements and Activities (continued)

In October 2014, SPTS filmed footage for the updated version of our flagship online training. Neptune High School donated the use of their school and production studio, as well as enlisted the assistance of a number of their talented students for on screen talent. SPTS partnered with The Trevor Project to develop the content for the LGBTQ information and once again recruited many experts to participate in the relaunch.

On February 11, 2015, Act on FACTS: Making Educators Partners in Youth Suicide Prevention was made available to the public at www.sptsuniversity.org. To date close to 3000 educators have completed the updated training and initial analysis is reflecting a significant increase in knowledge gained after completing the two hour program.

SPTS hosted a "Red Carpet Premiere Screening" of Act on FACTS on Tuesday, May 5 at Neptune High School to honor all involved in the project. NJTV featured SPTS and the training program on its evening news broadcast.

In November 2014 SPTS was proud to exhibit at the annual NJEA Convention in Atlantic City. For the first time, SPTS staff and volunteers were able to register NJ educators on site for our free online training. The SPTS booth was able to provide additional support information to school nurses following a presentation given by Denise Wegeman and Susan Tellone-McCoy on behalf of SPTS.

Dr. Barry Feldman continues to provide Lifelines training within the state of Massachusetts on behalf of SPTS. In the fall of 2014 he was able to secure training through the District Attorney's Office of Northampton to provide the complete Lifelines Trilogy training to the staff and administration of 12 school districts in Western MA. This training was in addition to state funded and local funding training he provided throughout the year.

In November 2015, SPTS was notified that the state of Arkansas received its first Garrett Lee Smith funding award. Maureen and Dr. Michelle Scott assisted the Arkansas team in developing their program proposal. SPTS is excited to begin a new working relationship with the state.

Patricia Breux joined SPTS as Program Director on January 1, 2015. Pat is the previous Youth Prevention Specialist for the Suicide Prevention Center of New York. She participate in many innovative projects, including a community initiative that certified over 200 trainers, as well as the training of over 16,000. As an ASIST and SafeTalk trainer, Pat has also trained over 2,000 participants in these trainings.

2014-2015 Achievements and Activities (continued)

As many of you are aware, SPTS was instrumental in NJ being the first state to adopt legislation requiring educators to have suicide prevention training. Scott and SPTS have been working with Assemblyman Troy Singleton, NJEA and the NJPSA to amend this legislation to ensure all school personnel receive information on suicide prevention and are aware of the resources and policies of their school. Additionally, Scott recently consulted with Montana to have similar legislation passed in their state. To date there are now 26 states with varying legislative efforts requiring educators to receive suicide prevention training.

On a local level, SPTS has been incredibly busy:

- Scott continues his representation on the Governor's Youth Suicide Prevention Council. He presented to parent groups at Hoboken High School, each of the Middletown Middle Schools and is scheduled for a number of schools this coming September.

- Maureen provided Lifelines training to Bordentown High School Staff in October 2014.

- Maureen and Scott have been working with the Burlingtown Township Community to provide postvention consultation and training following the loss of two students earlier this year.

- SPTS received grant funding from the Kenworthy Swift Foundation to provide Lifelines Postvention training to New York City School staff. Pat Breux trained over 100 NYC educators during trainings hosted in February and March of 2015.

- Pat Breux and Dawn Doherty presented at the NJ Association for Student Assistance Professionals in February 2015. Maureen Underwood will be a keynote speaker for the 2015 conference.

- SPTS is currently accepting applications from Monmouth and Ocean County high school students to join our Youth Council. The Youth Council Advisory Board was formed in 2014 and we look forward to engaging our youth in upcoming events and the development of new resources.

- On April 23, 2015 SPTS led a community collaborative to host a Youth Wellness Summit for Ocean County High School Students. A dozen public and private schools participated in the single day summit and received information on suicide prevention, substance abuse prevention and healthy relationships.

- NJ Transit introduced a suicide prevention awareness poster designed by SPTS to target the "young adult" population in a number of train stations on the North Jersey Coast Line, light rail cars and buses.

SPTS will be launching a new website this month that will include the addition of Spanish subtitles for our parent video "Not My Kid: What Every Parent Should Know". The Spanish subtitles will be made available on the thousands of DVDs distributed across the country within the next few months.

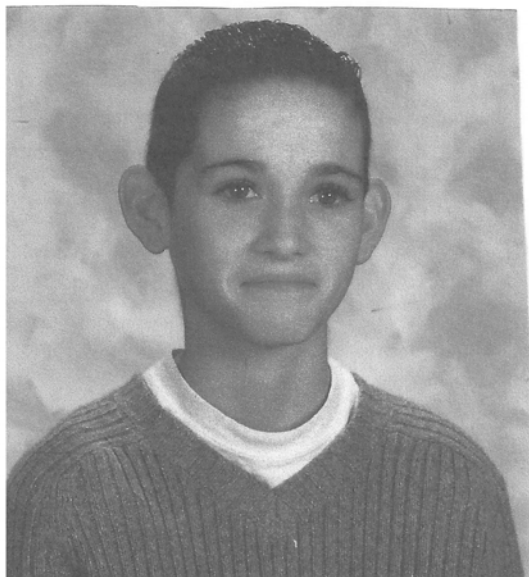

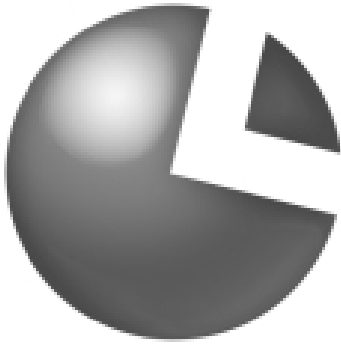

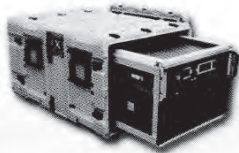
