#### 2015-2016 Achievements and Activities

We are most excited to share the success of our inaugural year of the SPTS Youth Council. During the past academic year, SPTS was supported by over 60 students that represented more than 20 high schools in Monmouth and Ocean County. The council met several times throughout the year, receiving education and presentations on safe messaging, best practices, coping skills and more. The council served as ambassadors of our organization, many of which bringing their new knowledge back to their schools and working to organize awareness efforts for their peers. The council helped advise SPTS to determine the workshop topics for the 2016 Monmouth County Youth Wellness Summit. We celebrated the dedication of our council members with a "graduation" hosted at iPlay America.

The Monmouth County Youth Wellness Summit was hosted at Neptune High School - where the space was generously donated by Principal Allen and the Board of Education. The Youth Wellness Summit was fully funded by a grant from the Investors Bank Foundation and supported by bank staff who volunteered. On April 5, 2016 almost 150 sophomore and juniors from almost 20 public and private schools in the county convened for a day of wellness. Students and staff participated in activities and workshops centered around mental and physical health and wellness. Feedback from the day was very positive and we have already scheduled the 2017 Summit which will take place at Brookdale Community College on March 14, 2017.

In February, SPTS and NJTV filmed the long-awaited Classroom Close-up segment at the Monmouth County Vocational Career Center in Freehold, NJ. In a partnership with Susan Tellone-McCoy, Denise Wegeman, LCSW, and SPTS Program Manager Nicole D'Amore, an hour presentation based off of the Lifelines Prevention curriculum was presented to 16 students at the high school. Youth council members from Biotechnology High School were also invited to become leaders in the presentation and worked with their peers from the vocational school to help discuss the ways in which teens play a vital role in suicide prevention.

Last year we shared the news that as a result of your generosity, we were able to update our online training. We are thrilled to announce that since June 15, 2015 we have trained an additional 30,000 educators across the country. We also had two states contract to offer custom programs to their school staff: South Dakota and Nebraska. Making Educators Partners in Youth Suicide Prevention will be the required course for all Nebraska educators in the 2016-17 academic year. Additionally, *Outcomes of a Suicide Prevention Gatekeeper Training Program,* an article on the SPTS Making Educators Partners in Youth Suicide Prevention training accepted for publication in *Crisis: The Journal of Crisis Intervention and Suicide Prevention,* and was presented at the national AAS Conference. We anticipate a nearly 50% increase in the number of educators who complete the course in the upcoming twelve months.

#### 2015-2016 Achievements and Activities (continued)

SPTS has also increased our presence on a local level over the past year. In September of 2015, during Suicide Prevention Awareness Month, SPTS provided presentations to: the staff and students of Neptune High School; the peer leaders at Rumson Fair Haven High School; the staff and students at Freehold Intermediate School; the parents and staff at Point Pleasant Borough High School.

Over the course of the rest of the year, SPTS provided presentations to: the students at Mater Dei Prep High School; the parents of Hoboken High Schools; the parents at Margate High School; the staff at Little Egg Harbor High School; Voorhees Township High School; the staff at Christian Brothers Academy; and the staff of Egg Harbor Township High School. Maureen Underwood worked with the communities of Burlington Township and Neptune to implement the Lifelines curriculum and better prepare the schools to manage a traumatic loss.

SPTS staff and volunteers distributed youth suicide prevention resources and information on our free online training to hundreds of New Jersey school staff at the annual NJEA Convention in November 2015. We are grateful to receive complimentary booth space to reach this target audience. SPTS was also represented at the NJ Association of Student Assistance Counselors Convention in February 2016, where Maureen Underwood closed the conference with her keynote speech.

SPTS ended the calendar year with a social media campaign in December. Nicole D'Amore, Program Manager and Youth Council Director, worked with council members to promote the You Are Not Alone campaign that reached 190,000 individuals across the internet. This campaign launched on December 2nd to signify suicide as the second leading cause of death for youth age 15-24.

In February 2016, SPTS welcomed Samantha Wilkins to the staff as Development Officer. Dawn Doherty, Executive Director and Sam will be working together to increase the level of foundation and corporate grant support for the organization and obtain funds to introduce new programs and expand the capacity of our current efforts. They will be working to enhance SPTS relations with our outstanding supporters and would welcome the opportunity to discuss future goals and initiatives of the organization with interested individuals.

SPTS placed second in the OceanFirst Crowdrise Challenge. With tremendous support from many of you, we were able to raise nearly \$60,000! We will receive a \$5,000 award from the OceanFirst Foundation that will be used to provide vital training and resources to our local communities in the upcoming year.

#### 2015-2016 Achievements and Activities (continued)

In the past twelve months SPTS has been involved in numerous projects and activities throughout New Jersey and across the country. Much of the work that we have been able to do on a local level is a direct result of your continued generous support. We hope you enjoy learning more about the impact that your giving is helping to make possible. Thank you again!

Maureen Underwood continued to travel across the country to provide suicide prevention training and consultation to the numerous states, continuing to strengthen existing relationships and building new ones.

- Maureen spent a great deal of time in Oklahoma to provide Lifelines implementation training to five communities through federal Garrett Lee Smith funding obtained by the state. Maureen continued her work with the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health consulting on the youth suicide prevention initiative for the state.
- Maureen provided Lifelines training and consultation throughout the state of Georgia. Building upon the Intervention training provided to 500 staff of Gwinnett County, Maureen returned to train school staff to implement the Lifelines Prevention curriculum into students' learning. She also worked with the school production staff to film video modules for suicide prevention.
- Following a presentation to community stakeholders in Midland, Texas in 2014, Maureen and SPTS was contracted to offer training for the school staff in the community. Maureen was also a keynote speaker in January 2015, speaking alongside the nation's leading experts in suicide prevention.
- Maureen recently spoke to the students of Mepham High School in Long Island. This presentation was arranged by Stacy Brief and was well received by the students.

Maureen will be leaving SPTS as a full time consultant later this month. SPTS would like to acknowledge the years of dedication and commitment to the organization and the field of youth suicide prevention.

Michelle Scott, Ph.D., former SPTS Board member, began providing training on behalf of SPTS. She has trained 35 individuals from the New York City Department of Health in a Train the Trainer for Making Educators Partners in Youth Suicide Prevention. These individuals are tasked with bringing the program to thousands of educators in the five boroughs of New York City, potentially impacting 50,000+ youth. This training was made possible by grant funding obtained by SPTS staff by the Kenworthy Swift Foundation. Grant funding was also received from the Achelis Bodman Foundation to provide Lifelines Intervention and Prevention training to New York City school staff, that will be scheduled for the Fall of 2016.
