2016-2017 Achievements and Activities

In September 2016 we welcomed Phyllis Alongi on staff as SPTS Clinical Director. Phyllis, a long time Monmouth County resident boasts decades of experience as an educator, in school based counseling, private practice and trauma response in Ocean County following Superstorm Sandy. Phyllis has very quickly become an essential part of the SPTS team. In December, she and six additional highly qualified trainers were certified by Hazelden Publishing as Lifelines Trainers. This increased the capacity of the organization to respond to local communities in need of suicide prevention training. Phyllis has ingratiated herself in the numerous Monmouth County coalitions and task forces that SPTS participates as a member in and has started to participate in similar groups in Ocean, Atlantic and Cape May counties which will effectively expand our reach and increase recognition of our organization and the vital resources we have available to educators, parents and teens.

Phyllis provided Lifelines implementation training to the school districts of Hamilton Township in Mays Landing and Ocean City. In September she will begin the training for Jackson Township. In May, thanks to grant funding from the Ocean-First Foundation, Phyllis provided Lifelines Intervention and Prevention training to educators in Monmouth and Ocean Counties. SPTS continues to respond to request and present to school administration across the state and will hopefully have many more local schools to include in this list next year.

SPTS remains one of the nation's leading experts in teen suicide prevention. In the spring when Netflix released its new series "13 Reasons Why" there was a great deal of unrest and concern around the safety of the messaging to youth. Phyllis Alongi fielded over a dozen requests for interviews from media outlets to share her knowledge and the SPTS view. SPTS was most proud of her contribution to a 2-page article printed in People Magazine quoting her expertise and listing SPTS as a vital resource. If you, as a parent or loved one of teens, have not yet educated yourself on this series we invite you to review the blog post on our website or speak with Phyllis directly.

September also marked the beginning of the second year of the SPTS Youth Council supporting the high school students of Monmouth and Ocean Counties. We are proud to report that we had 66 students representing 21 schools who attended monthly meetings to increase their personal knowledge about suicide prevention, learn positive, healthy coping mechanisms and life skills that will assist them in navigating their life journeys, and continued to inform the programs and resources SPTS offers to youth. The Youth Council was the driving force behind the May "Walk for Wellness: A Stride Against Suicide". The student committee planned the event, solicited sponsors, designed the logo and recruited walkers. They played an instrumental role in the success of SPTS Awareness Walk and will leave their legacy with the continuation of this event as a tool to increase awareness and decrease stigma within our community. The event was acknowledged with a proclamation from the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders, presented by John P. Curley, naming May 7 as "Strides Against Suicide Day."

2016-2017 Achievements and Activities

The council. once again, helped advise SPTS to determine the workshop topics for the 2017 Monmouth County Youth Wellness Summit. Thanks to a partnership with Brookdale Community College, arranged by new Board member, Anne LaPorta, the Youth Wellness Summit was able to be offered to public and private high schools in both Monmouth and Ocean Counties. The Youth Wellness Summit was partially funded by a grant from the Manasquan Bank Foundation and supported by numerous local businesses. As a result of the late March snowstorm this year, the event was rescheduled and hosted on May 23, 2017 with close to 200 sophomores and juniors from 24 public and private schools in the county convening for a day of wellness. Students and staff participated in activities and workshops centered around mental and physical health and wellness.

SPTS was excited to announce the expansion of the Youth Council at the Youth Summit. The 2017-18 academic year will introduce two Youth Councils - one for Monmouth County and one for Ocean County. This effort will increase the programming into Ocean County and allow SPTS to share the important lessons and messaging with more teens across the state. Another positive addition to the Youth Council program was the introduction of 3 scholarships for high school seniors involved. The Board of Directors and Staff believes so firmly in this program they wanted to show appreciation to those involved and honor the hard work and dedication. With grant requests submitted, SPTS hopes to expand into a third county and/or introduce a Middle School Youth Council for the 2018-19 academic year.

Grant funding provided by The Provident Bank Foundation allowed SPTS to offer Teen University workshops to students in Monmouth and Ocean Counties. Since we know that students are not receiving Evidence-based suicide prevention curriculum in schools, SPTS has afforded this valuable opportunity to students in a community workshop format. The students who have attended the first two sessions praised the information discussed, the friendly and knowledgeable presenters and confirmed value of and the need to learn this information. SPTS will be announcing the summer and fall dates shortly and hope that you will encourage teens in your life to join us.

Act on FACTS: Making Educators Partners in Youth Suicide Prevention continues to be one of the top training programs in the country. We are thrilled to announce that we surpassed the 200,000 mark with number of educators who have completed our course. Resulting from an existing relationship with the New York City Department of Education, SPTS trained 30 of their staff to present the training to school staff across the 5 boroughs to fulfill regulations introduced by the School Chancellor of New York City. These individuals have presented to over 10,000 of their peers since February 2016. Additionally, SPTS has presented in person to over 2000 school staff in New Jersey. Phyllis recently presented a Train the Trainer webinar to afford the opportunity to 25 individuals to train in Osceola County Florida.

2016-2017 Achievements and Activities

The SPTS team continues to grow and strengthen. Joanna Ollinick joined the team as the Youth Council Manager and did an amazing job building the program over this last year. Joanna's experience as a school guidance counselor combined with her outstanding personality and genuine demeanor provided the best experience for our council members and we look forward to another year with her as Monmouth County Youth Council Manager. Marcie Bradley, LCSW will be joining SPTS as the Ocean County Youth Council Manager. Marcie is the school social worker for Point Pleasant Schools and we are confident she will provide nothing but the best to the high school student participants in Ocean County. Colleen Corbett recently joined the team as Office Assistant and has complimented the office very well, stepping up to assist with managing the Youth Wellness Summit planning and the Golf & Tennis Outing registration process. We look forward to Colleen growing with the organization. Samantha Wilkins celebrated her first year anniversary with SPTS and expanded her family in January when she and her husband welcomed their first child. SPTS Executive Director, Dawn Doherty, will be celebrating her 5th year with the organization and third in the ED role. She has been representing SPTS as a member of the 2017 NJ Lead Class and continues to build relationships at the local and state level that will help enhance suicide prevention efforts across NJ. SPTS has been honored to welcome new members of the Board of Directors with the induction of Curt Knazick, Rob Marrone and Malia Segal, LSW in November and Anne LaPorta in May.

We would also like to highlight outstanding third party fundraising that SPTS has been honored to be the recipient of. In the fall, Tiffany Gibbs selected SPTS to benefit from her Gran Fondo bike event and raised nearly \$25,000 to help support our programs. Stacy Brief, who many of you heard from at the Wine Tasting in the Fall has continued her support to SPTS during her first year of college. SPTS is also grateful to the Estate of Larry Paragano who donated \$10,000 to the mission of SPTS. Sargent Greg Bogert of the Riverdale Police Department has been raising money over the past year to bring Lifelines Training into the Butler School System, which should hopefully be happening in the fall. Another great THANK YOU to everyone who supported our OceanFirst Crowdrise campaign resulting in SPTS being named grand prize winner and the recipient of the \$20,000 grant that will be used to support our local programming. On a regular basis we receive donation checks from school and community groups who raise funds for our very important cause. We are so appreciative and welcome you to contact us to learn more about supporting SPTS with your school, youth group or company. Too often families who have lost loved ones to suicide request memorial donations to SPTS; this is a humbling reminder of the reason we are in existence. With your continued support we know that we can positively impact communities and save young people from suicide.
